

AAUW Amador Branch 2023 Home Tour FAQ's

- 1. Where is the Home Tour this year?** The location is Sutter Creek, an historic town in Amador County Gold Country.
- 2. How many Home Tours has your Branch hosted?** This is number 48.
- 3. When is the Home Tour?** This year the Home Tour is Saturday, April 22, 2023.
- 4. What time is the Home Tour?** The Tour hours are 11 am to 4 pm.
- 5. When do tickets go on sale?** Tickets will be available starting March 15, 2023.
- 6. How much do tickets cost?** Pre-Tour Day tickets purchased through Brown Paper Tickets will be \$40.00 (plus a processing fee). Tickets purchased at the local outlet will be \$40 (cash or check only). Day-of-the-Tour tickets will be available at the Home Tour Tea for \$45.00.
- 7. How do I purchase tickets?** Tickets will be available through Brown Paper Tickets and through a local Amador County outlet. A link on our Branch website (amador-ca.aauw.net) will take you directly to our Brown Paper Tickets event site.
- 8. How many homes are on the Tour?** Five homes are scheduled on the Tour, plus if you have extra time, there will be suggestions to visit Sutter Creek Historic sites.
- 9. What type of homes are on the Tour.** We cannot provide details at this point, but the homes range from historic homes that have been updated but retain their historic ambiance to newer construction with historic touches.

10. Is the Tour walkable? The homes are all situated within a walkable area. Be aware that this is an historic gold rush town which involves hills, steps and walking on uneven surfaces. Most sites have multiple levels and numerous steps and stairs. Not all homes are handicapped accessible. As always parking in Sutter Creek is limited so walking is encouraged. We will have parking attendants available at several sites to assist you if you need to drive between homes.

11. Is there parking? There are several public parking lots in Sutter Creek. Locations will be shown on the Home Tour map available soon on our website.

12. Are there restrooms available? Public restrooms are available and will be listed on the Home Tour map.

13. Will Refreshments be served? The Creekside Methodist Church, 14 Main Street, Sutter Creek is the location of the ever-popular **Home Tour Tea**. This is the place to sit and relax with a cup of coffee, tea or a cold drink and taste some delicious homemade cookies.
You'll be able to browse a selection of gift baskets created by AAUW members and community businesses, the proceeds of which will support our scholarship fund-raising efforts.

14. Is lunch available? Sutter Creek offers several restaurants from which to choose. Check out Yelp or the Sutter Creek city website (suttercreek.org) for listings.

15. Is the Home Tour a fund-raising event? The Amador branch of AAUW supports local women and girls by using proceeds from the Home Tour for college scholarships, Tech Trek scholarships awarded to middle school girls to attend a weeklong summer math and science camp, community projects and educational programs both for Branch members and open to the public.

16. Can I join AAUW? Membership information is available on the Branch website (amador-ca.aauw.net) and there will be additional information and an opportunity to join at the Home Tour Tea.

17. Is my ticket purchase tax deductible? Yes, a portion is tax deductible (\$24.00 for a \$40.00 ticket and \$27.00 for a \$45.00 ticket).
