Sutter Creek Fire Museum – Main Street, Sutter Creek

Preserving the fire history of Amador County started in 2005 when the Sutter Creek Fire District (SCFD) and the Sutter Creek Volunteer Fire Department (SCVFD) decided to begin the Fire History Projects to commemorate the 100-year anniversary of the Sutter Creek Fire District. The purpose of these projects is to research, preserve, recreate and display the local fire departments' history and make the results available as a tourist attraction for the county.

Sutter Creek Firehouse was built in 1934 and actively used until just a few years ago. In the front of the building, visitors will see the work being done to recreate the first firetruck, a 1924 Dodge pickup truck that was converted by local mechanics for firefighting.
